

## Downloading eBooks to a NOOK/NOOK COLOR

**If you haven't registered your Nook with Barnes & Noble, do so.**

Visit the Peotone Public Library website at [www.peotonepubliclibrary.org](http://www.peotonepubliclibrary.org)

Click on the ebook tab. Then click on the Quick Start Guide.

In order to read OverDrive eBooks with your Nook, you will need to download and install the Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) program on your laptop or PC.

You will also be prompted to create a free Adobe Account so you can authorize your Nook. Please use the same email address and password you used for your Barnes & Noble account.

Visit Peotone Public Library's website at [www.peotonepubliclibrary.org](http://www.peotonepubliclibrary.org) and click on the ebook tab.

Go to the Advanced Search, and click on the EPUB format from the dropdown menu. This is the file format that the Nook supports.

Also check mark "Only show titles with copies available."

Click on "Add to Cart." Click on "Proceed to Checkout."

Select your home library. Then enter your library card number.

Click on "Confirm Checkout." A drop down menu will allow you to specify a lending period (7, 14 or 21 day checkout).

Click on "Download."

Click on "Open" and your book will appear in your ADE library.

Plug in your Nook with your USB cable and turn it on.

Click on the book to transfer it to your Nook. Drag it into the Nook icon on the left hand side. The book will now show up in your Nook's Library.

So to review...Check out, Download, Drag and Drop, and you're ready to read.
